WHICH ORGANS CAN BE DONATED?

Heart, Lungs, Liver, Kidneys, Pancreas, Small Intestine

WHO CAN DONATE?

Living donor

Living individuals can donate a kidney part of a liver, lung, bone marrow or blood

Deceased donor

An individual whose brain activity has permanently stopped and is declared brain dead by an M.D.

Donation after circulatory death

An M.D. determines a patient has no hope for a meaningful recovery. If the family decides to remove artificial support some organs & tissue would be eligible for donation

DID YOU KNOW?

- Anyone can be a potential donor regardless of age, race or medical history
- Most religions support donation as a final act of love & generosity
- The donor's body is treated with respect & dignity
- There is no cost to a family to donate their loved one's organs & tissue
- An open casket is possible after donation
- Buying and selling organs & tissue is illegal in the U.S.
